A. Learning Continuity and Attendance Plan (Public Hearing - Discussion)

Background: Per Senate Bill (SB) 98, all Local Education Agencies (schools) in the state of California must adopt a The Learning Continuity and Attendance Plan. This takes the place of the normally required Local Control Accountability Plan that would have been adopted in June of 2020 for school year 20/21. The Learning Continuity and Attendance Plan outlines how the school plans to offer continuity of education for students while ensuring attendance which this year is considered engagement. The plan is a key part of the overall budget package for the K-12 that seeks to address funding stability for schools while providing information at the local educational agency (LEA) level for how student learning continuity will be addressed during the COVID_10 crisis in the 2020-21 school year. The plan is intended to balance the needs of all stakeholders, including educators, parents, students, and community members while streamlining engagement. Plans are to reflect the ongoing need for LEAs to formally plan to return to school in the midst of the uncertainty of COVID-19.

The Learning Continuity and Attendance Plan memorializes the planning process for the 2020-21 school year and includes descriptions of the following: addressing gaps in learning; conducting meaningful stakeholder engagement; maintaining transparency; addressing the needs of unduplicated pupils, students with unique needs, and students experiencing homelessness; providing access to necessary devices and connectivity for distance learning; providing resources and supports to address student and staff mental health and social emotional well-being; and continuing to provide school meals for students. Requirements including governing boards adopting the plan by September 30 in a public meeting. Prior to its adoption, the plan shall be presented at a public hearing of the governing board for review and comment by members of the public.
