Fourth and fifth graders have officially started their Doris Niles Science Fair Projects. If you see a 4th or 5th grader, ask them how it is going!

The science fair is a week-long event (March 16th - 20th) held at HSU, celebrating excellence in science for students in 4th grade through high school. This event honors the memory of Dr. Doris Niles, a beloved, Humboldt County teacher who helped further students' and teachers' science education.

Students participate within a variety of categories such as Physical Science, Life Science, or Math and Engineering. Over 100 volunteer judges review displays and conduct student interviews throughout the week, culminating in an awards ceremony where 125 medals and special recognition awards are presented. Fuente Nueva also celebrates their accomplishments by displaying all their projects on Science Night, on February 27th.

Deep Seeded Farm is only a few minutes' walk away from Fuente Nueva. 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## The latest from Fuente Nueva Charter Council

This month, the charter council will be receive updates from our various committees on the topic of the budget, comprehensive safety plan, LCAP development and exploration of options for Spanish learning in the middle school years. Meetings are always open to the public and are held in the staff lounge.

## Notification from the County Department of Agriculture

The County Department of Agriculture has informed the school about upcoming pesticide use on Sun Valley Farm, which is located close to Fuente Nueva. California regulations require a farmer to provide annual notification of the pesticides expected to be applied to agricultural crops within a quarter of a mile of a public K-12 school or a licensed childcare center (schoolsites). The pesticides are expected to be used during the July 1, 2019 - June 30, 2020 period.

The law provides strict guidelines to the farm on how and when they can apply the named pesticides. Directora Beth is in the process of meeting with the farmer and a representative from the County Department of Agriculture to further define how and when notification is provided.
