IMPORTANT! Fuente Nueva participates in the National School Lunch Program. Free and reduced-price meals are available to students who live in a qualifying household based on their Application for Free and Reduced-Price Meals. A new application is required for each school year (one application per household). If you believe your child(ren) may qualify for free or reduced-price meals, it is important to submit your application to the school office as soon as possible because free or reduced-price meals begin the day we determine your eligibility. The school only receives reimbursement for these meals from the federal and state programs after the household members are determined to be eligible. It is the responsibility of parents to pay for meals until their application is approved. Applications are available in the school office and may be submitted at any time during the school year. After we receive your application we will send a letter informing you of your status.
