Floor Upgrade Summer Project

You will come back to a different school in the fall! On the last day of school, we will say good-bye to the students and begin the large task of putting the school into storage containers. Once we are moved out, contractors will start the process of removing the floors in the hall and the school. This project will be overseen by the parish, as they are funding most of the project. The floors, as you know, contain asbestos, but it is non-friable so the task of removing it is less arduous. Air quality tests will be taken before and after the work is done. All necessary safety precautions will be followed. The new floors will be industrial tile that will brighten up our classrooms and take less annual maintenance.
